DRESS CODE & CONDUCT

PARTICULAR GUIDELINES FOR MEN

KEY: MASCULINE AND APPROPRIATE

- a. Men should be clean-shaven each morning.
- b. Men should bathe on a daily basis and use deodorant
- c. Men should keep their hair neat and clean. No extreme hairstyles or hair coloring. Sideburns must not be lower than the middle of the ear. Hair should be tapered in the back and off the brows.
- d. No "baggy" pants or sloppy appearance.
- e. No "muscle man" T shirts are worn in public except for beach wear.
- f. Neat collared shirts for regular school apparel
- g. Sandals are worn for off days ONLY.
- h. Sweats or walking shorts may be worn for appropriate activities. Always check with team leader before wearing either.
- i. Always bring a T-shirt to wear during swimming activities.
- j. Limit "cargo" type slacks. Cargo pants are never worn as dress pants.
- k. One long sleeved white oxford shirt is necessary for dress code needs.
- l. Tan Khaki slacks are necessary for Team Outfit days.
- m. Nails should be kept neat and trimmed.
- n. No tattoos maybe obtained while a college student, drama team or staff member.
- o. NO "faddish" or "extreme" hairstyles will be tolerated.
- p. No shirts with names of groups or organizations maybe worn, unless they are sports teams.
- q. Be sure to bring a pair of "grubby" clothes that can get paint on them or be used for maintenance work.

PARTICULAR GUIDELINES FOR WOMEN

KEY: MODEST & APPROPRIATE

- a. No tight clothing.
- b. No clothing that calls attention to the form of a woman.
- c. No blouses that are too short and cannot cover the waistline when bending or stretching.
- d. No "spaghetti" straps or thin straps that reveal underclothing.
- e. No low cut, hip hugging skirts or slacks.
- f. No low cut blouses that are more than four finger widths from collarbone.
- g. No "cut in" sleeveless blouses.
- h. Walking shorts or culottes - no shorter than 2 "above knee.
- i. Slacks are permitted for appropriate occasions.
- j. Tight jeans are **NEVER** appropriate.

- k. Hosiery should be worn for performances and church services when the team members are taking part in the service.
- l. Black closed toe, low heeled, shoes should be worn for performance. (A basic black pump)
- m. Full-length slips are to be worn for all performances. (To knee or ankle, whichever is appropriate to dress being worn.)
- n. A modest one piece bathing suit with a modest cover-up to wear to and from the swimming area.
- o. Hair should be kept neat, clean and styled. No *extreme* hair styles or *coloring* may be worn while in college or on staff.
- p. Make-up maybe worn in moderation.
- q. No piercing of face or body is allowed. One set of pierced earrings is allowed in the ear lobe.
- r. No tattoos maybe obtained while a student or staff member.
- s. Skirts must come to the top of the knee when seated and slits in skirts may not come above the bend of the knee whether in front, rear or side of the skirt.
