G.A.P. PROGRAM 2017-2018

Our goal during this program is for each Intern to “**Gain A Perspective**” on life, on their gifts and abilities, and to jump in whole-heartedly into our ministry. Whether that is sweeping floors, acting on the stage, or working behind the scenes, every Intern will receive invaluable hands-on experience in a unique performing arts ministry. Interns will be involved in whatever activity or production is scheduled for the Logos Theatre.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Working on production preparation
 - Rehearsing for the production as cast and/or crew
 - Being assigned to a crew and working in that department (costumes, makeup, stage construction, marketing and promotions, graphic design, stage lighting, office assistant, film and media assistant, etc.)
 - *An Intern may request to work in a certain department of their interest, but the assignment of each Intern will be made depending on the overall needs of the ministry at that time.
 - Cleaning before or after a production
- Performing in plays or concerts in the theatre
- Maintenance, yardwork, and meal clean up
- Helping and assisting with the projects outside of the Theatre in which the Academy is involved
 - Bible Club
 - Assisting local churches with their cantatas (Christmas, Easter, etc.)
- Other responsibilities may arise with the unique aspects of our performing arts ministry, and each Intern should be ready to help in whatever way is needed.

SCHEDULE

- Monday – **OFF** (With the exception for production times when extra rehearsal or preparation is needed)
- Tuesday-Friday
 - Chapel each morning where you will be taught Biblical truth and doctrine
 - English class which will include grammar and professional writing etiquette (twice a week)
 - Weekly Bible Memory quiz given after chapel on Friday
 - A block of 2 hours each day where the intern can sign up for 30 minute sessions with an instructor in a certain area of work in which the Intern is interested. That 30 minute session is a time for the Intern to come with questions about that specific department.
 - The rest of the day, the Intern will be assigned to help in whatever department they are needed depending on the needs of the ministry.
